McKinney-Vento Act identifies homeless children and youth as those who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence. Such as: Doubled-up with other persons due to loss of housing, hardship or similar reason.

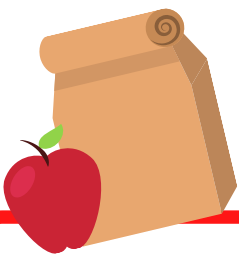
Project HELP's primary focus is to assist students in temporary living situations due to economic hardship or crisis. Project HELP assists school age children with access to AISD and local support services such as:



- Enrollment assistance for students in temporary living situations and students in foster care
- Immunization information
- Assistance with records
- Support services for unaccompanied youth
- Tutoring services and information
- Referral to community services
